It has taken a long time and a lot of effort to compile these exercises, answer keys, and other materials, but I believe it has all been worthwhile. Students often comment on how beneficial they have found the exercises (and sometimes even ask for more!). My hope is that you will make good use of them and even, perhaps, enjoy them along the way.
